FAU subscribes to dozens of databases. Listed below are **full text** databases compatible with the DMAC curriculum. These databases cannot be accessed from DMAC or home computers. To access any FAU database, you must go to the Boca Raton campus and use a computer in their library reference area. This area is on the first floor to the right as you walk into the library. You do not need an FAU library card to enter the library or use the computers.

Art / Image Databases

Art Index Full Text | 1984-present | Vendor: H.W. Wilson

■ **Contents/Info:** Subjects include Advertising Art, Antiques, Archaeology, Architecture and Architectural History, Art History, Crafts, Decorative Arts, Folk Art, Graphic Arts, Industrial Design, Interior Design, Landscape Architecture, Motion Pictures, Museology, Non-Western Art, Painting, Photography, Pottery, Sculpture, Television, and Textiles. **Full-text coverage for Art Index with Full Text begins in 1997.**

ARTstor | Vendor: ARTstor Inc.

■ **Contents/Info:** ARTstor is a non-profit initiative, founded by The Andrew W. Mellon Foundation, with a mission to use digital technology to enhance scholarship, teaching and learning in the arts and associated fields. The ARTstor Digital Library Charter Collection is a repository of hundreds of thousands of digital images and related data and tools to actively use those images. [If you want to be able to make full use of ARTstor, you will need to register. You may register on campus or off campus via EZproxy.]

Design & Applied Arts Index (DAAI) | (Index Only) 1973-present | Vendor: CSA

■ **Contents/Info:** The Design and Applied Arts Index (DAAI) contains over 130,000 annotated references from more than 500 design and craft journals and newspapers published from 1973 onwards, and data on over 50,000 designers, craftspeople, studios, workshops, firms etc., making it the largest index of its kind in the world. Research articles are covered, along with topical news items, conference and seminar reports, and book, video and exhibition reviews. Each reference includes full bibliographic details and a brief abstract. DAAI also includes two supplementary databases: *Education Directory* and *Periodicals Directory*.

NYPL Digital Gallery | Full Text | Vendor: NYPL

■ Open Access

■ **Contents/Info:** NYPL Digital Gallery is the New York Public Library's new image database, developed to provide free and open online access to thousands of images from the original and rare holdings of the Research Libraries. Spanning a wide range of visual media, NYPL Digital Gallery offers digital images of drawings, illuminated manuscripts, maps, photographs, posters, prints, rare illustrated books, and more. Encompassing the subject strengths of the vast collections of the Research Libraries, these materials represent the applied sciences, fine and decorative arts, history, performing arts, and social sciences.

Visual Collections | Full Text | Vendor: FCLA

This scholarly collection offers information in nearly every area of academic study including: computer sciences, engineering, physics, chemistry, language and linguistics, arts & literature, medical sciences, ethnic studies, and many more. Academic Search Premier is an enormous collection of the most valuable peer-reviewed full text journals, offering critical information from many sources unique to this database.
